CLUB RULES ON CARTS:

Midlands has separate rules on electric and gasoline carts. So to even up the playing field, the Tournament Committee decided on ITEM #4 below:

- 1. 2 players per cart.**
- 2. Golf bags may be loaded in the carts.**
- 3. Caddies MAY drive the carts, if authorized by the players. Players shall be liable for cost of repairs to damaged golf carts and club property as well as damages caused by caddies authorized by them to drive the golf carts.**
- 4. During the game, caddies MAY ride the carts, provided that that there is a **MAXIMUM OF 2 PASSENGERS PER CART, AT ALL TIMES.****
- 5. The only time a cart is allowed to hold more than 2 passengers is when the players go to their assigned holes and when they go back to the clubhouse, after the game.**



FRIENDLY REMINDERS:

1. Players should be at their assigned holes 15 minutes before the shotgun start. Players who arrive at their assigned holes after the shotgun is fired will be disqualified.
2. The tournament must be played in 5 hours. The siren or shotgun will sound off at 11:30 AM for morning players, and 5:15 PM for afternoon players, to signify the end of game for all players. Everyone must immediately pick-up their ball and leave the course. Players who do not complete 18 holes will incur an X score for any unfinished hole.
3. After their game, the morning players must return immediately to the clubhouse as the golf carts used will be needed for the afternoon round.
4. Changes may need to be made to the schedule and division of classes depending on the number of entries submitted. The committee reserves the right to make the necessary changes.
5. On cell phones:
 - a. Phones must be kept on silent mode at all times. Use of cellular phones is allowed for text messaging only and must not cause undue delay. If a player is observed to be causing undue delay due to continued use of the cellular phone for text messaging, penalties will be applied based on USGA Rule 6-7: UNDUE DELAY; SLOW PLAY. Ringing Phones and voice calls on the fairway will be considered a serious breach of golf etiquette.
 - b. The host club as well as the players must inform their caddies to turn off their cellular phones.
 - c. Protests, if any, must be done in writing and addressed to the WGAP Board.
6. A senior player aged 55 & above can rent her own golf cart at her own expense at PhP 800 per cart (2-seater).
